Supporting Your Child's Emotional Health

- **Communicate** - create a safe space to discuss their feelings/emotions
- **REASSURE** and **VALIDATE** their feelings, thoughts, frustrations
- Create **routine and structure**
- Share your own **coping skills** and what works for you when feeling upset/frustrated/etc
- Spend time together practicing deep breathing, **mindfulness**, yoga, and other calming strategies
- Reinforce **positive behaviors** (5 positive statements to every negative statement)
