Friday, September 6, Noon: Senior Class Dues (\$120) and Homecoming T-Shirt Sizes Due

Homecoming is very early this year (September 27) so we need your t-shirt sizes by noon on Friday, September 6th via MySchoolBucks. Since Senior Dues are mandatory for all students and must be paid in order to walk at graduation, t-shirts will be ordered for all Seniors. Pay dues on MySchoolBucks by Noon on September 6th to receive your desired t-shirt size. Class dues cover all graduation expenses (cap/gown, bus to graduation, DAR Constitution Hall rental, programs, diplomas, etc.) as well as the class t-shirt, senior class trip, senior picnics, Ethics Day forum, senior treat days and more.
