Supporting Your Child's Emotional Health

- Communicate create a safe space to discuss their feelings/emotions
- REASSURE and VALIDATE their feelings. thoughts, frustrations
- Create routine and structure
- Share your own coping skills and what works for you when feeling upset/frustrated/etc
- Spend time together practicing deep breathing, mindfulness, yoga, and other calming strategies
- Reinforce positive behaviors (5 positive statements to every negative statement)


