Up to Day 1	Counselors begin working out schedule conflicts & errors	Two HPE9 courses in schedule Enrolled in course that was completed over the summer
	Elective changes will not be considered beyond this point	
Week 1-2	Counselors balance courses as possible.	 Two World History classes have 28 and 23 students, by adjusting two students' art classes, the classes now become 26 and

Week 3-8	No movement permitted.	First assessments can create an overly reactive response when a course change will not ultimately be necessary
