#### Introduction

Schoology is our online Learning Management System (LMS), where parents and students may participate in these activities:

- Parents obtain lessons and resources for teaching their students.
- Students find lessons to work on in class and at home. They may participate in online discussions, assessments, and other educational activities.
- Important school and class information is shared.

Everyone needs to have a basic understanding of Schoology in order to access lessons. Depending on the grade level and program in which students are enrolled, you may need a little more knowledge.

### **Schoology Courses**

Courses are where you will find lessons, resources, and other information about student courses. All students are enrolled in at least one course. The course is where teachers and students interact.
